In a major step towards digital transformation and improved members engagement, the Nigerian Society of Engineers (NSE) has officially launched the NSE Digital App. This innovative platform is designed to streamline operations, enhance communication and provide seamless access to services for members.

Speaking, on Thursday, June 19, 2025, during the brief ceremony which held at the National Engineering Centre (NEC) Headquarters, Abuja, The President of NSE, Engr. Margaret Aina Oguntala, FNSE,

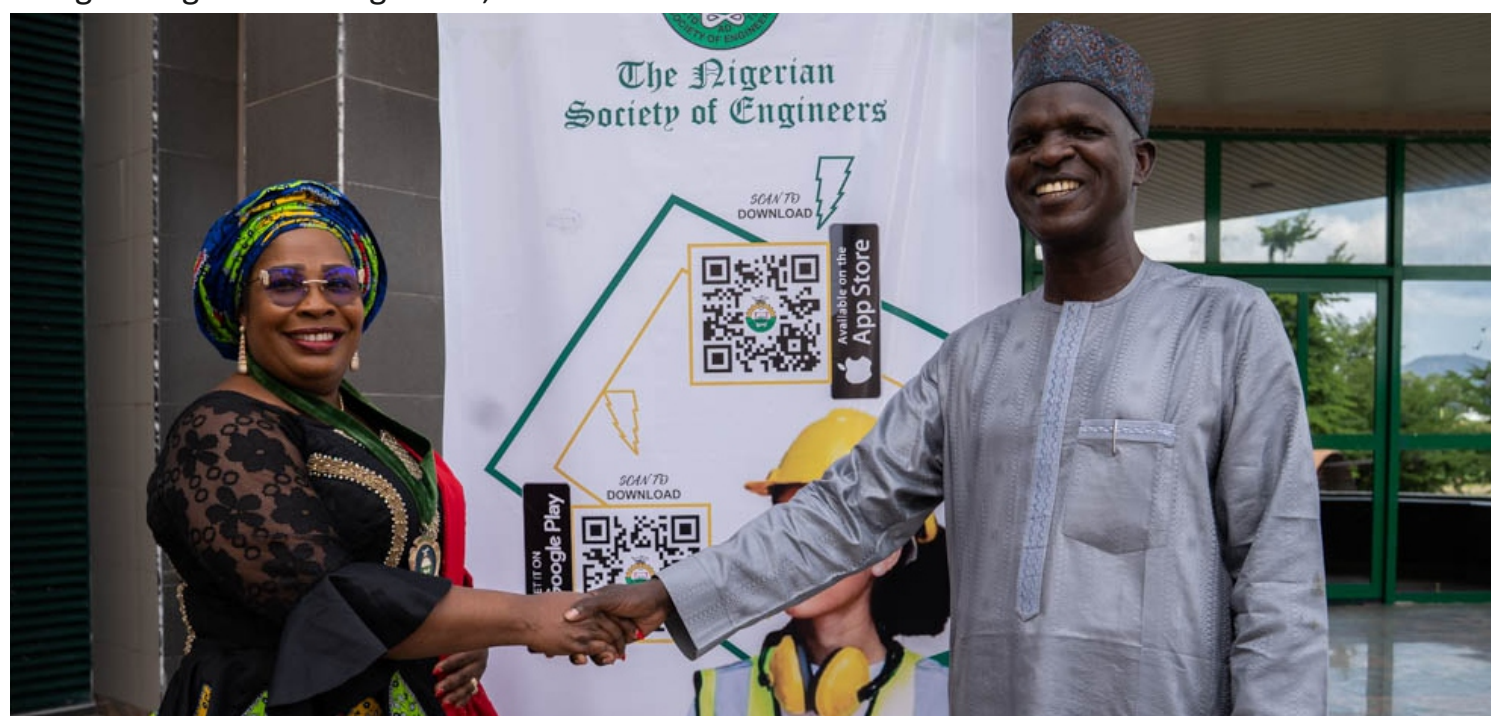
described the development of the App as a critical move towards positioning Nigerian Engineers as key players in national development and global competitiveness.

Engr. She explained that the App was designed to eliminate longstanding bottlenecks that have hindered effective interaction between members and the NSE Headquarters. According to her, the new platform will bridge this gap by enhancing accessibility and responsiveness, noting that particular attention was paid to ensuring that the App is user-friendly, enabling remote access to key services, delivering a safer, more efficient and cost-effective platform for members to stay engaged.

Performing the official launch on behalf of the federal government, the Director General of the National Information Technology Development Agency (NITDA),

Mr. Kashifu Inuwa Abdullahi, who was represented by the Director, e-Government and Digital Economy Development, Engr. Dr. Kaka Salisu, FNSE, commended the Nigerian Society of Engineers for the laudable initiative. He described the development of the NSE Digital App as a clear demonstration of local content innovation, an ideal that NITDA has been mandated to promote vigorously.
